EqualLogic Firmware is a SAN operating system integrated across the entire family of EqualLogic storage arrays; which virtualizes SAN resources and provides intelligent data management functionality. An essential component of the software is the capability to automatically adjust system resources, optimizing performance and capacity, and reducing human intervention.

EqualLogic Firmware is a full-function SAN operating system providing features natively that are often expensive add-ons with other SAN vendors. Features like automatic load-balancing, thin provisioning, snapshots, replication and multi-path I/O are just a few of the features integrated in EqualLogic Firmware.

EqualLogic Group Manager is a SAN management tool integrated with the EqualLogic Firmware that provides detailed information on SAN configuration, and provides storage managers with an easy-to-use tool for storage provisioning, replication scheduling and array management. The EqualLogic Group Manager is available as a command line interface (CLI) or java based graphical user interface (GUI) that can be accessed from Microsoft[®] Internet Explorer[®] or Mozilla[®] Firefox[®] web browsers with a connection to the EqualLogic SAN.

EqualLogic Manual Transfer Utility is a host based tool that enables the secure transfer of large amounts of data using removable media. Integrated with the native replication function of the EqualLogic Firmware, EqualLogic Manual Transfer Utility is beneficial in environments where data protection is critical but bandwidth is limited.
