An End-to-End Approach

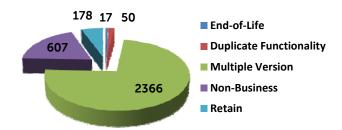
Dell's global, scalable and cost effective approach to application management uses best-in-class inventory and analysis tools.

Application Inventory. The first step toward application management is to inventory all applications in your environment. Dell will work with you to discover, identify and categorize these applications using a discovery agent and database that recognizes more than 87 million off-the-shelf application executables.

Dell will analyze the data to identify targets for rationalization by filtering out non-business applications, multiple versions of the same application and applications with redundant functionality. The key deliverables of the Application Inventory phase include an interpreted list of applications and a plan to rationalize the application portfolio. It will also produce information to prioritize applications for Windows 7 compatibility testing.

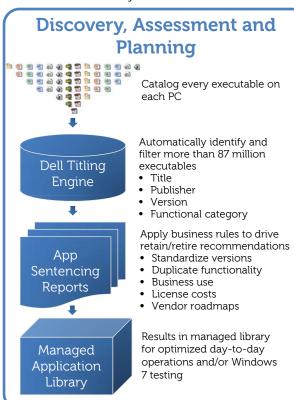

Application Rationalization. Following the Application Inventory phase, Dell will work with you to rationalize targeted applications. Using industry-proven best practices for application rationalization, Dell will drive a business case for each application.

A Sentencing Report will be created that recommends whether to retain, retire or upgrade the application based on the following criteria:

- Duplicate and redundant application functionality
- Business use of the application
- Licensing costs
- Support costs
- Known Windows 7 compatibility

By rationalizing the master list of applications, subsequent phases of application management such as Windows 7 testing, licensing expenses and support costs will become more attainable. The rationalization list can also be used to define and implement a definitive media library.



Additional Application Management Offerings

Windows 7 Compatibility. Our comprehensive testing process identifies compatibility issues with the current application portfolio, so you can properly scope and budget your Windows 7 migration project.

Following the Rationalization phase you will receive a tiered breakdown of applications in your environment, based on their criticality to the business. From this list you can select either automated or manual testing of each application tier, based on importance to the business and the complexity of the application.

Requirements Gathering and Packaging. Dell consultants gather the comprehensive installation instructions and requirements on all applications that need packaging.

We convert targeted applications to the appropriate package format to facilitate silent, unattended installs. Minimal onsite engagement is necessary throughout the packaging phase, leading to significant cost savings.

Testing and Distribution. Dell will facilitate the User Acceptance Testing (UAT) process to ensure the final package meets your approval before it's deployed into the end-user environment.

In the final phase of the Application Management process, Dell consultants can configure the package for electronic distribution via SMS/SCCM or several other electronic software distribution systems.
