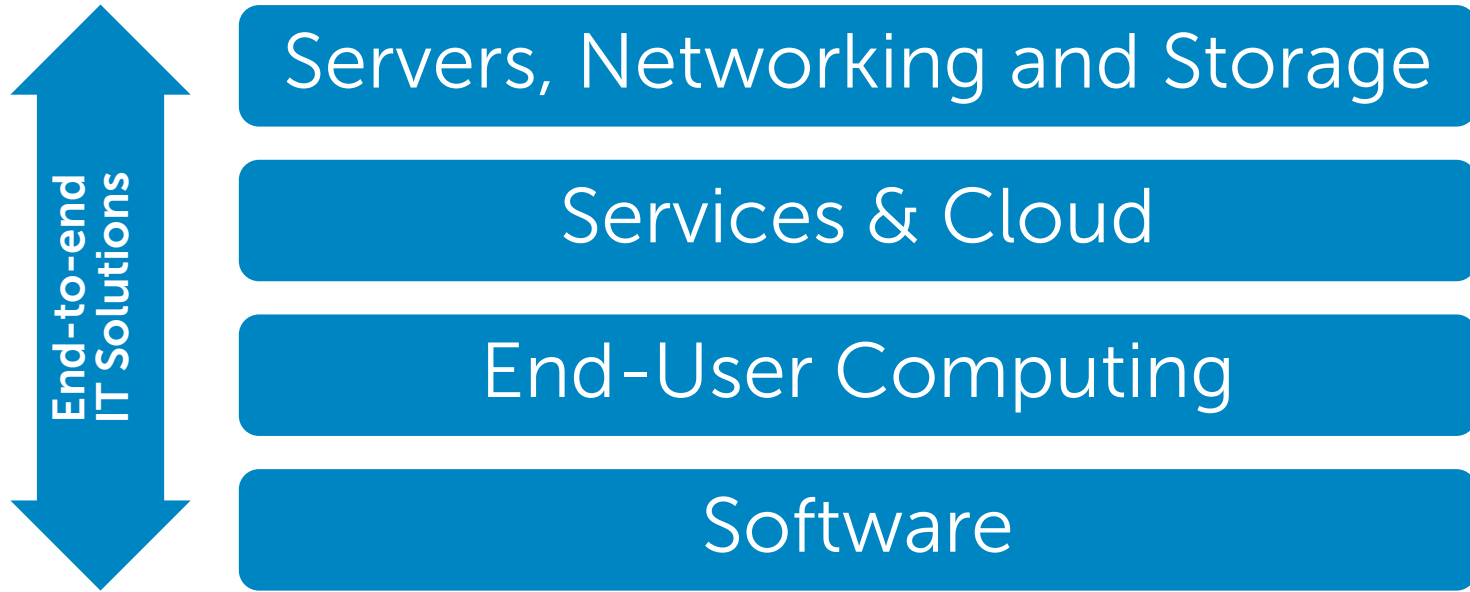

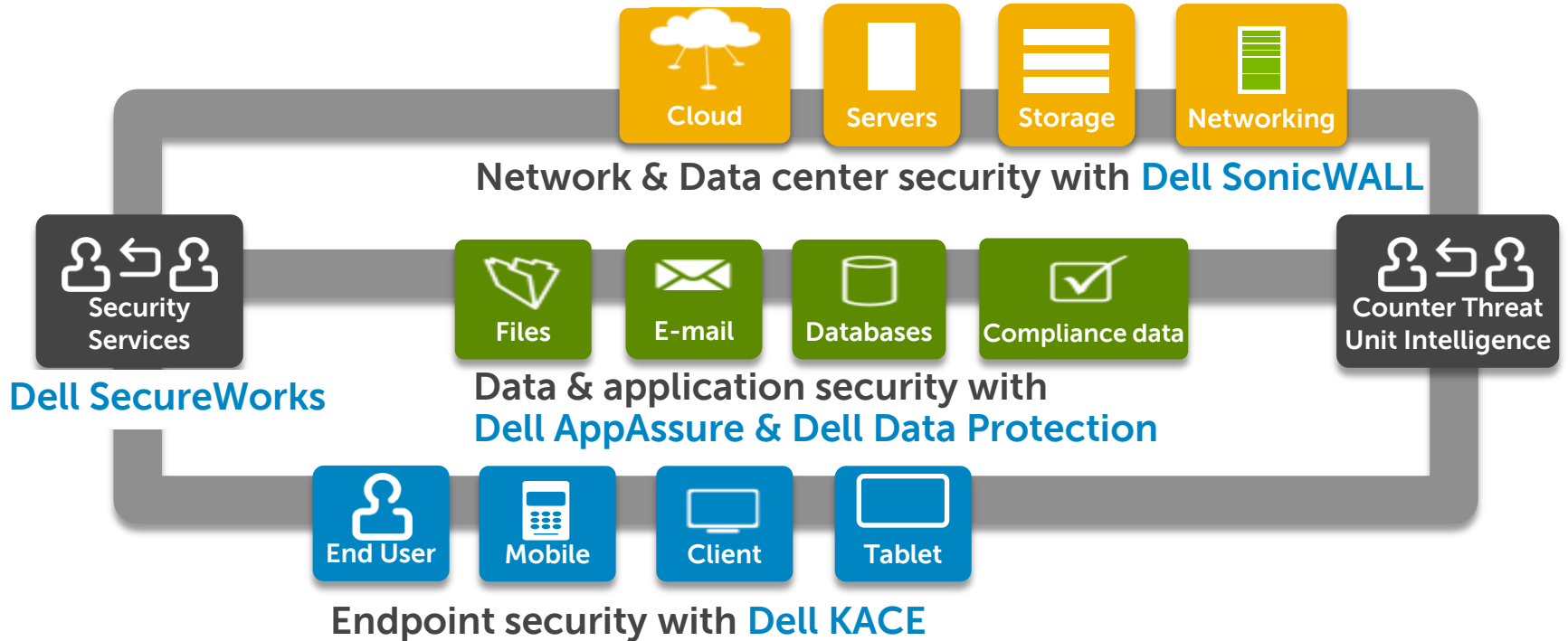
- Security remains a big concern for CIOs and Dell is committed to addressing that concern by offering leading security solutions
