## Why not iSCSI?

Fibre Channel over Ethernet gets all the hype for unifying data centres; is iSCSI not up to the task?

Even though Fibre Channel over Ethernet gets all the hype, iSCSI over Ethernet is just as capable of converging or unifying data centre servers, storage and networking, proponents say. 40/100G Ethernet needed, but too pricey.

The key component in the unified data centre is lossless Ethernet, according to Fibre Channel and iSCSI advocates. Yet there is a religious war brewing between the two camps on the best way to integrate storage into an Ethernet-based unified data centre fabric.
