



## COMMISSION REGULATION 801/2013 (ErP Lot 26)

<b>Network</b>	A communication infrastructure with a topology of links, an architecture, including the physical components, organizational principles, communication procedures and formats (protocols)
<b>Network standby</b>	A condition in which the equipment is able to resume a function by way of a remotely initiated trigger from a network connection
<b>Network availability</b>	The capability of the equipment to resume functions after a remotely initiated trigger has been detected by a network port
<b>Remotely initiated trigger</b>	A signal that comes from outside the equipment via a network
