

How to generate multiple license files



STEP 1 Open and sign into your Dell Digital Locker account

Open **Tools** page, then License Activation link; Unactivated license tab; select Download Products to bind

Advanced Solutions

To activate up to 1000 software licenses, download a CSV template with the licenses that need binding to hardware. Then add the binding assignments to the file and upload it.

Binding instructions for products with a Service Tag

- Click "Submit" to download a CSV file.
- The CSV file contains all of the entitlements to be bound to the selected product.
- Do not add or remove any columns or rows in the file.
- Enter a Service Tag for each entitlement.
- Upload the updated CSV file by selecting "Upload binding assignments" on this screen, and then follow the on-screen instructions.

STEP 2

Select a product to download and save a CSV with the information required to generate a license.

Open the downloaded CSV file and enter the required information and save it on your system



STEP 3

Enter required information for each product that you want to generate a license.

Open **Tools** page, then License Activation link; Unactivated license tab; select Upload binding assignments

Locate and Validate CSV file



STEP 4

When validation is selected the CSV file content will be checked for completeness. You can then verify that the information was loaded correctly.

After validation, select to Upload the CSV file. If there are issues in the validation select Start over, then update the CSV and re-upload and validate again

STEP 5

Once information is verified, select upload to generate a zip file containing the license key files.

Open **Tools** page, then Download Files link; Files ready for download will be available in your account for 240hrs (10 days). After 10 days they will be removed.
